MEDJUGORJE Recently the Holy Father spoke of the many gifts that have come to the Church through pilgrimages to Medjugorje, and repeated his permission for Parishes to promote and encourage these pilgrimages. However, he did not rule on whether or not the apparitions themselves were authentic, and strongly advised pilgrims to keep in mind that the main purpose of their pilgrimage was not to meet with the supposed visionaries but to have an encounter with Mary, the Queen of Peace, and to encounter Christ and listen to Him through Word and Sacrament.
