**'ASSISTED DYING'** As you may be aware there is a great push from some quarters to make the ending of life for the terminally ill legal and, indeed, normal. While this may seem like a compassionate legislation this is very far from being the case. If enacted it would soon result in pressure being put on the old and the dying to 'do the decent thing' and end it rather than continuing to be a drain on the NHS and the economy. Such legislation would also deny the value of suffering. But Christ suffered on the Cross to bring us salvation and, because of His suffering, all suffering is of great value.

It is expected that Parliament might vote on this matter before Christmas. As Catholics it is up to us to uphold the value and true dignity and worth of human life. So I would urge you to contact your MP to let them know where you stand on this issue.
