#### **HOLY YEAR OF 2025: PILGRIMS OF HOPE**

The Holy Year, or year of Jubilee, has been inaugurated in Rome by Pope Francis, and no doubt many will visit Rome during this year. The Jubilee, however, is something that the whole Church can and should participate in. To help us in this we have booklets available with explanations, hymns and prayers for the Jubilee. Also in the book are highlighted six specific areas for us to ponder and pray about.1] Care for Creation; 2] Food Poverty; 3] Modern Slavery; 4] Managing Debt; 5] Forgiveness; 6] Rest and Worship. We hope to arrange meetings in our Parishes to focus on these issues and what should be a Christian response to them. The booklets are £1.50 each.
