PILGRIMS OF HOPE/YEAR OF JUBILEE The Jubilee used to be a time of restitution and new beginnings. Throughout this year we shall be hosting a series of meetings in our churches to pray about and consider the main themes of the year. We begin on **Tuesday 18 February** at Our Lady of Grace, from **5-6pm**. We will begin with a time of prayer in the church followed by a period in the Parish Room for talk and discussion on the theme of 'Care for Creation': what it means, why we should do it and how we might make it a reality. Our 2nd meeting in this series will be in Easter Week, on 22nd April at St Augustine's at the later time of 6.30pm. The subject will be 'Food Poverty.'
